HTML Structure

This theme is a fixed layout with two columns. The header's (content with logo and main menu) is within a div with an id of "header".

The screenshot slideshow is within a div with an id of "intro" . The slideshow divide in 3 section in 3 different div: captionsslideshow, introright and slideshow. I'm using jCarousel Lite to create the slideshow effect:

All of the information within the main content area is nested within a div with an id of "maincontent". The sidebar's (column on the right) content is within a div with an id of "nav".

The footer's is within a div with an id of "footer"

CSS Files

I'm using three CSS files in this theme. The first one (style.css) is a main css files, it contains generic reset file. Many browser interpret the default behavior of html elements differently. By using a general reset CSS file, we can work round this. This file also contains some general styling, such as anchor tag colors, font-sizes, etc. Keep in mind, that these values might be overridden somewhere else in the file.

The second file (ie.css) is a css file for Internet Explorer 6, and the last file is (ie7.css) for Internet Explorer 7.

The main css file (style.css) is separated into sections using:

Line 1-60 is CSS *reset*, do not change that line. If you want to change the url color, go to line 21 and change the color hexadecimal.

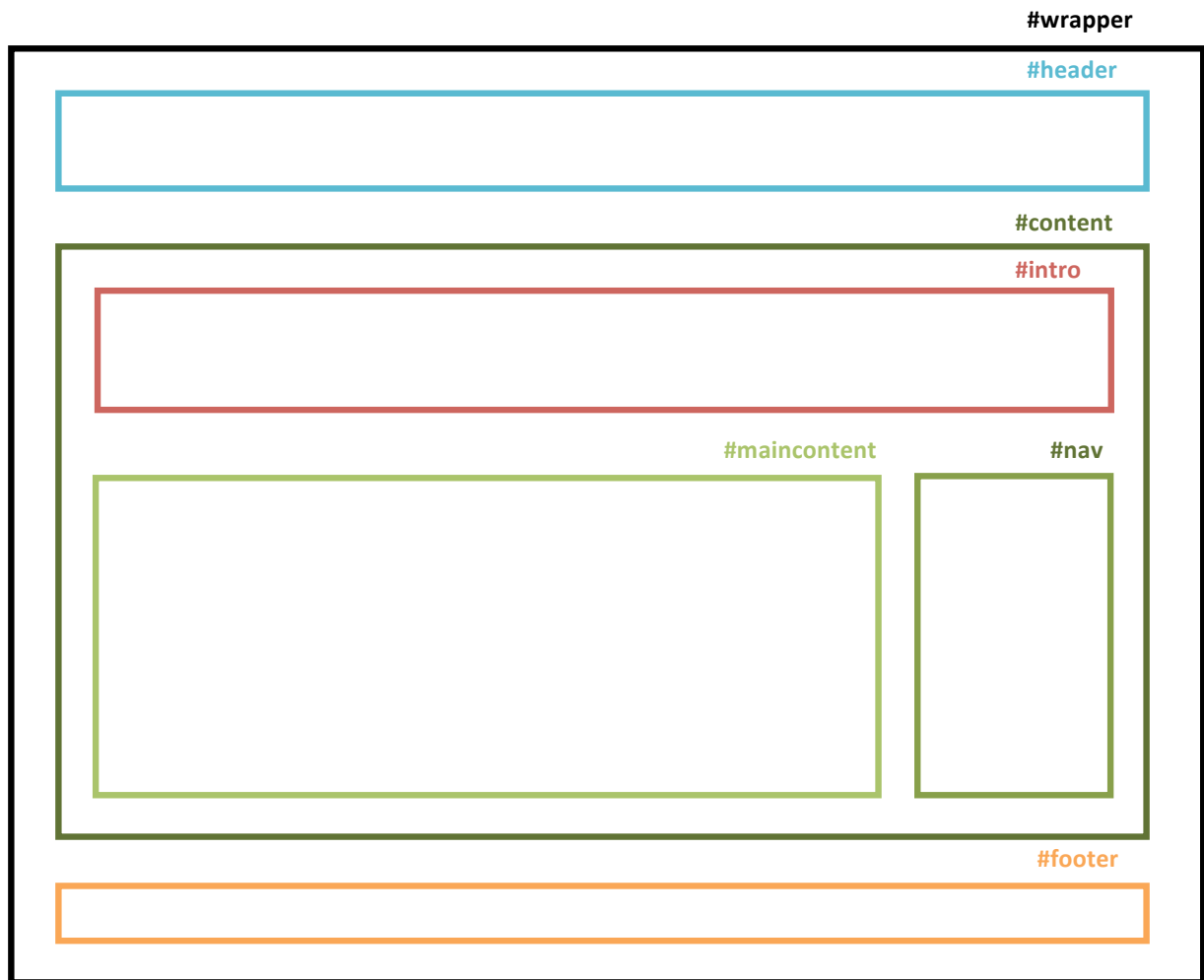

This section is another CSS reset, you can change background and font on this section. To change the background color and main font style, go to line 39-41.

This section is style for Drop Down menu. The drop down menu style start from line 187 to 229. In HTML code you can see the drop down on **Our Services** menu and **Color**. Just add this code if you want add another drop down menu. For example we will add another drop down menu on Our Services:

"errordiv" to show error message, and "correctdiv" to show correct message.

If you would like to edit a specific section of the site, simply find the appropriate label in the CSS file, and then scroll down until you find the appropriate style that needs to be edited.

This template use *em* not *px* for *font-size*. So use *em* if you want to change the font size.

9px = 0.9em

10px = 1.0em

- **Logo**

The logo size is 237 x 64 px. Just replace *logo.png* on *images* folder with your *logo.png* file. The logo must be transparent png files. You can also edit the logo from logo.psd to get the correct size.

Javascript

This theme imports four Javascript files.

1. jQuery (jquery.js)
2. IE6 PNG Transparancey Fix (DD_belatedPNG.js)
3. Slideshow using jCarouse Lite (jcarousel.js & easing.js)
4. Tabs using jQuery UI Tabs (ui_core.js & ui_tabs.js)
5. Lighbox (lightbox.js)
6. Twitter (gettwitter.js & twitter.js)

1. **jQuery**

jQuery is a Javascript library that greatly reduces the amount of code that you must write.

2. **IE6 PNG Transparancey Fix (DD_belatedPNG.js)**

DD_belatedPNG is a Javascript library to give PNG transparency support into IE6.

I'm using jCarousel Lite to create the slideshow on. Open index.html, there are 3 div for the slideshow: **slideshow**, **captionslideshow** & **introright**:

The images for slideshow must be 503 x 190 px.

Slideshow.js

Slideshow.js is the javascript to control the slideshow, you can edit it to change the animation. Here's the code:

Speed: To change the animation speed.

Vertical:true To make the animation move vertical, remove it to make it move horizontal

Easing: This is the easing animation, you can change it with: swing, easeInQuad, easeOutQuad, easeInOutQuad, easeInCubic, easeOutCubic, easeInOutCubic, easeInQuart, easeOutQuart, easeInOutQuart, easeInQuint, easeOutQuint, easeInOutQuint, easeInSine, easeOutSine, easeInOutSine, easeInExpo, easeOutExpo, easeInOutExpo, easeInCirc, easeOutCirc, easeInOutCirc, easeInElastic, easeOutElastic, easeInOutElastic, easeInBack, easeOutBack, easeInOutBack, easeInBounce, easeOutBounce, easeInOutBounce

4. Tabs using jQuery UI Tabs

jQuery UI Tabs is a User Interface for jQuery to create tabs based layout with jQuery. This templates use jQuery UI Tabs to create the tabs navigation on navigation. I'm using tabs on navigation. Here's the HTML code to create Tabs:

5. Lightbox

Lightbox is a Javascript library to create the popup images with jQuery. To create the lightbox effect, add 'popup' class into <a> and point it into bigger images. Example:

6. Twitter

This template have working last post twitter with Javascript. This twitter load within:

<p id="texttwitter"></p> On the footer.

Open gettwitter.js and change the id (line 2) with your twitter username.

Contactus.html

If you want to show the *error message*, edit contactus.html and uncomment / remove line 94 & 98. If you want to show the *thankyou message*, edit contactus.html and uncomment / remove line 99 & 103

Contactus.php

This template contain working contact form with PHP. You must have PHP installed on your server to make it works. You just need to edit contactus.php go to line 130 and change it with your email address.

PSD Files

I've included four psds with this theme:

1) homepage.psd

This is the main psd for the layout. The psd has been sliced, you can select it by using "Slice Select Tool" in Photoshop.

2) logo.psd

This is psd file for the logo. Just edit it and save it into logo.png

3) aboutus.psd

This is psd for aboutus.html.

4) newsdetail.psd

This is psd file for newsdetail.html.

5) newslst.psd

This is psd file for newslst.html.
